



New Hampshire Fastbreak

Parent's Q&A Sheet

Q: Why do we need to pay a fee for the tryout?

A: AAU requires that all those trying out are insured by the AAU organization. Also, we must pay for the court fees at the SportsZone.

Q: How do I know which age division my son will qualify for?

A: For boys, it is determined by what grade you are currently in:

<u>Division</u>	<u>Grade</u>	<u>Age on 9/1/2008</u>	<u>Age on 9/1/2008 (Age Exception)</u>
15U	9 th	≤15	16
14U	8 th	≤14	15
13U	7 th	≤13	14
12U	6 th	≤12	13
11U	5 th	≤11	12
10U	4 th	≤10	11

Q: How many Age Exception players are allowed on a team?

A: No more than three.

Q: I do not live in New Hampshire. Can I still play on a NH Fastbreak team?

A: If you live in Massachusetts, Maine, or Vermont you are considered a Border Region player. There can be up to three Border Region players per team.

Q: Can my son play up to a higher division?

A: The AAU rules allow it. Please check with the NH Fastbreak staff at the registration table. We will address this on a case-by-case basis.

Q: How many teams will there be for each age division?

A: That will depend on the number of players attending the tryouts. We anticipate having enough players for two or more teams per division.

Q: How many players will be on each team?

A: Each team will roster between 10 and 12 players at the discretion of the Head Coach.

Q: My son plays another spring sport. Will that be okay?

A: We do not want to discourage boys of this age from participating in other spring sports, however in order to play on the NH Fastbreak, AAU basketball must be your son's first extra-curricular priority. If you have questions about this, please see one of the NH Fastbreak staff at the registration table before the tryouts.

Q: How much will it cost for the entire season?

A: That will depend mainly on how many tournaments the team attends, and where the practices will be held. Younger teams usually go to fewer tournaments than older teams. You should expect to pay roughly between \$400 and \$800. (This does not include travel expenses to tournaments).

Q: How will I find out if my son makes a team or not?
